

# Cwmbran 3G Footwear Policy

Cwmbran 3G is a brand new 3G sporting facility. It is in everyone's best interests to keep the quality of the playing surface high. This footwear policy has been created to minimise wear on the playing surface and prevent compression and damage of the surface.

This policy applies to **everyone** using the 3G surface including players, coaches, medical staff, referees, assistant referees, volunteers, etc.

<b>Permitted</b>	Football boots with moulded plastic studs NB: studs (not blades) Rugby boots with metal studs designed for rugby <sup>note 1</sup> Artificial Ground (AG) soleplates  Note 1: Metal screw-in studs designed for rugby conforming to and Kite Marked to BS 6366:2011 are permitted provided that all studs are in good condition and fully tightened so that they cannot capture turf fibres.
<b>Accepted but not recommended</b>	Astro Trainers in good condition
<b>Not Permitted</b>	Blades, dimpled and flat soled shoes: including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Trainers</li><li>• Soft ground (SG) or Soft Ground Pro (SGP) soleplates</li><li>• Boots with Moulded Blades</li><li>• Shoes, work boots, socks, flipflops, etc.</li></ul>

Additionally, please note:

1. All footwear must be clean and free from mud, soil and stones. (Mud & soil will ruin the surface and stones may injure players).
2. Using incorrect footwear can increase injury, may damage the footwear and will damage the playing surface.
3. The 'playing surface' comprises the entire carpeted area.
4. It is the Hirer's responsibility to enforce the footwear policy. Violation of the policy may result in cancellation of the booking and no re-booking – please see the Terms and Conditions.
